Frequently Asked Questions

Q – Do I need a permit to remove less than 10 trees on my property?

A – A permit is not required, however you do need to ensure you have met the canopy coverage outlined below. If you are not able to determine the canopy coverage please fill out the application and supporting documentation and the City will be happy to assist you. There is no cost associated with this application. You are not permitted to remove trees required by zoning, trees located in a stream buffer or a floodplain.

Minimum Tree Canopy Coverage Required by Land Use

Residential, Single-family attached or two-family	20%				
Residential, multi-family	20%				
Residential, fee simple townhouse	15%

Required Documents

- 1. Tree Removal Application.
- 2. A site plan showing location of the trees to be removed and location of the trees (s) to be replanted. Please indicate tree species.
- 3. Photos of tree/s to be removed.
- 4. If tree to be removed is a Specimen Tree, please provide letter from Arborist documenting the condition of tree and reason for removal.

Q – Do I need a permit to remove more than 10 trees on my property?

A – In removing more than 10 trees a land disturbance permit will be required. The cost will be \$150 the following documentation will be required:

Required Documents

- 1. Tree Removal Application.
- 2. Land disturbance plan plan showing trees to be removed and how erosion will be prevented.
- 3. Landscaping plan showing tree replacement (canopy coverage must be met).
- 4. Photos of trees to be removed.
- 5. If tree/s to be removed are classified as a Specimen Tree, please provide letter from Arborist documenting the condition of tree and reason for removal.



Tree RemovalFrequently Asked Questions

- Q How do I know if the trees to be removed include a specimen tree?
- A The application provided shows the steps in determining if a tree is classified as a specimen tree.
- **Q** How long is the review process?
- A The review process may take 5 to 10 business days.
- **Q** What will happen if I do not meet the canopy requirement?
- **A** The applicant will be required to replant trees or add additional trees. Any other requirement by the City will be communicated to the applicant.
- Q How do I measure DBH?
- **A Step 1**: measure circumference of tree trunk at 4.5 feet above ground: With the measuring tape, measure 4.5 feet up the trunk of the tree from the ground. Wrap your string or pliable tape measure around the tree trunk at 4.5 feet. Measure the length of string (or take reading on pliable tape measure) to get the circumference of the tree.
- Step 2: Divide the circumference by 3.14 = DBH
